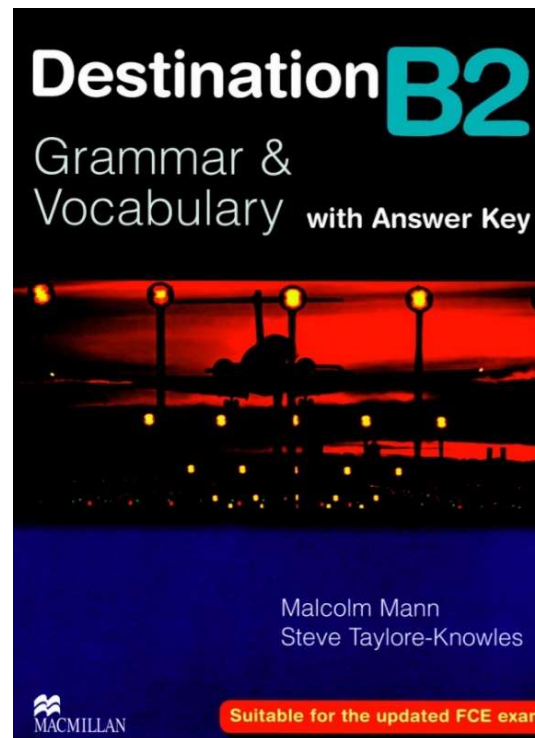

FAQ 16: Will I be able to do all the **BEd**-courses at one of the institutions in **Linz**?

“SALZBURGTAG” English (Tuesday) – Winter 2021/22

Course registration starts on 16 September and ends on 22 September. All students will initially be placed on a waiting list. After 22 September, based on capacity, students will be assigned a place on each course and confirmation will be sent out.

Some courses are more popular than others and may fill up very quickly. As a consequence, students may not get a place in the course they wish to take, so remain open to the possibility of changing into a different course. Even if a course appears to be full, sometimes students drop out in the first week of classes and additional places open up.

When registering for a course in PLUOnline, the system will check whether you have taken the respective prerequisite courses, so make sure that you meet all requirements and your final marks have been entered. If this is the case but you still experience problems signing up for a class, please send an email to lehramt@sbg.ac.at where you can get help registering.

(3) Masterarbeit

Wird die Masterarbeit im Unterrichtsfach Englisch verfasst, gelten folgende Bestimmungen:

- a) Die Masterarbeit soll einen Mindestumfang von 30.000 Wörtern Fließtext aufweisen; darin ist der dem wissenschaftlichen Standard entsprechende Apparat (Bibliographie, Anhang, etc.), den die Arbeit ebenfalls zu enthalten hat, nicht eingerechnet.

- b) Wenn die Masterarbeit im Unterrichtsfach Englisch verfasst wird, muss das Seminar Masterarbeit ebenfalls im Unterrichtsfach Englisch absolviert werden. Vorrangiges Ziel ist es, den teilnehmenden Studierenden eine Plattform für die Präsentation und Diskussion von Forschungsergebnissen und deren strukturierter Aufarbeitung zu bieten. Für einen positiven Abschluss ist die Präsentation, Diskussion und Abgabe der folgenden Texte erforderlich: Struktur bzw. Inhaltsverzeichnis, Einleitung und ein Kapitel im Umfang einer Seminararbeit.
