Some courses are more popular than others and may fill up very quickly. As a consequence, students may not get a place in the course they wish to take, so remain open to the possibility of changing into a different course. Even if a course appears to be full, sometimes students drop out in the first week of classes and additional places open up.

When registering for a course in PLUSonline, the system will check whether you have taken the respective prerequisite courses, so make sure that you meet all requirements and your final marks have been entered.
