Course registration starts on 05 September and ends on 24 September. All students will initially be placed on a waiting list. After 24 September, based on capacity, students will be assigned a place on each course and confirmation will be sent out.

Some courses are more popular than others and may fill up very quickly. As a consequence, students may not get a place in the course they wish to take, so remain open to the possibility of changing into a different course. Even if a course appears to be full, sometimes students drop out in the first week of classes and additional places open up.
